departments took part in the event. Students from the NCC Society also participated in the celebration enthusiastically.

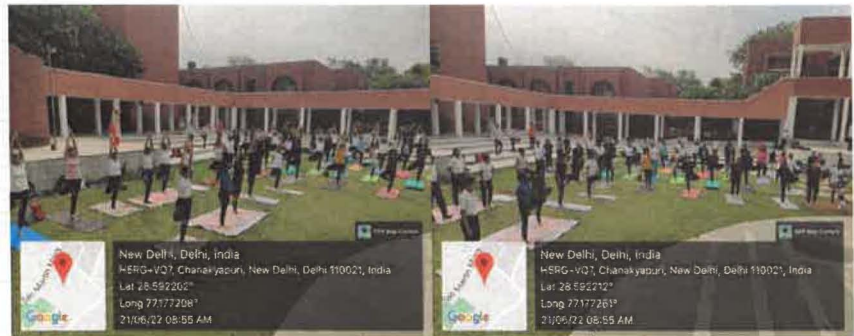

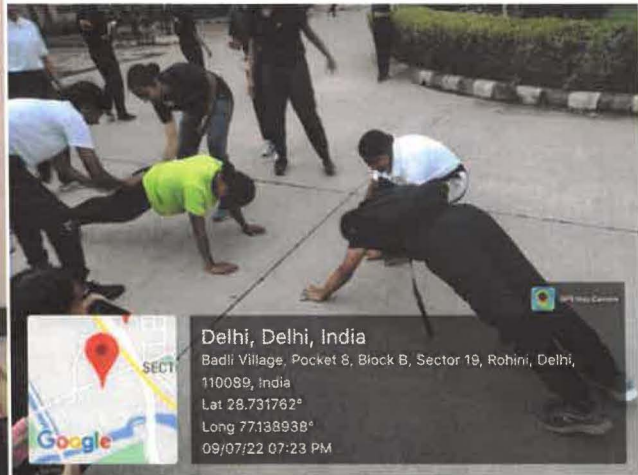

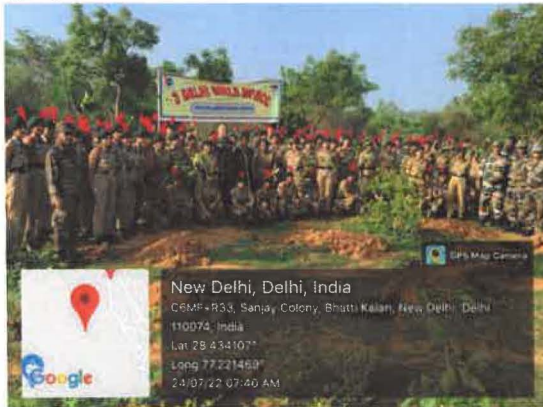

The life-giving energy that surrounds us, helps us breathe the fresh oxygen, and gives everything it has without expecting anything in return, is none other than trees.

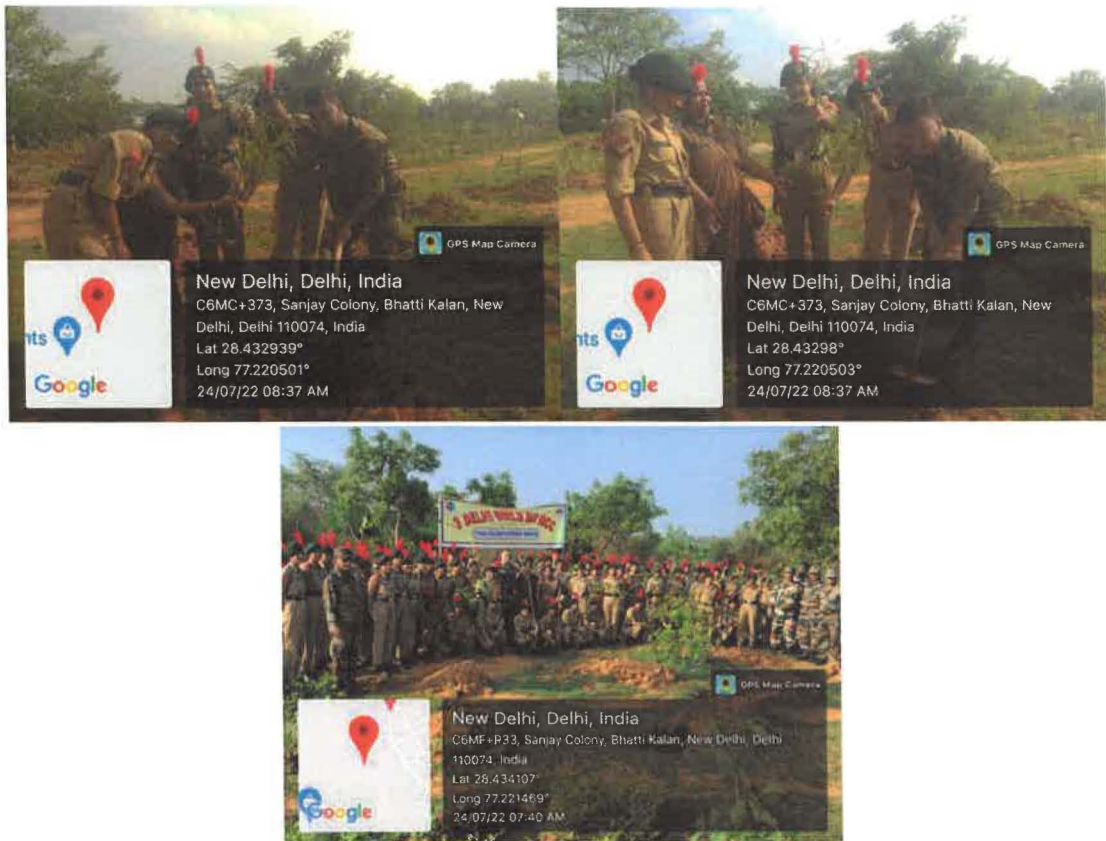

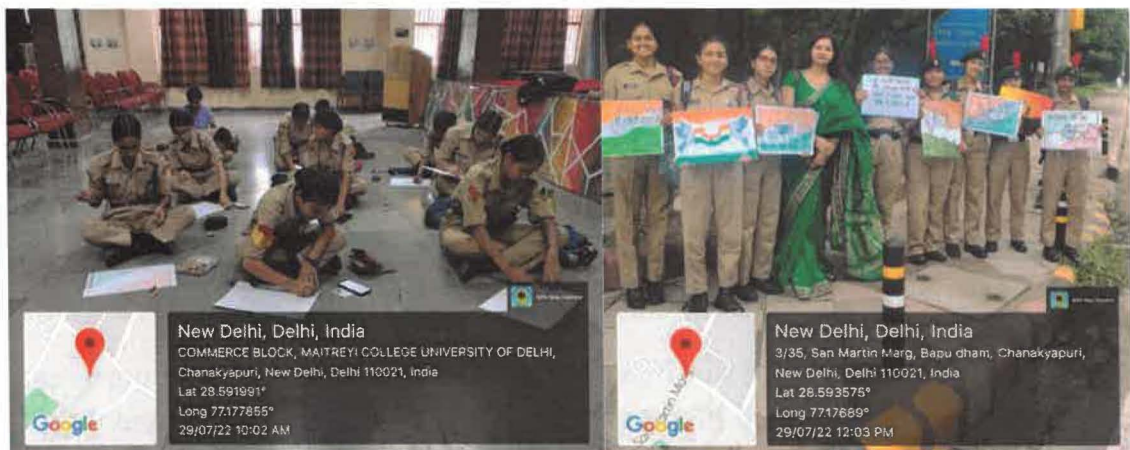

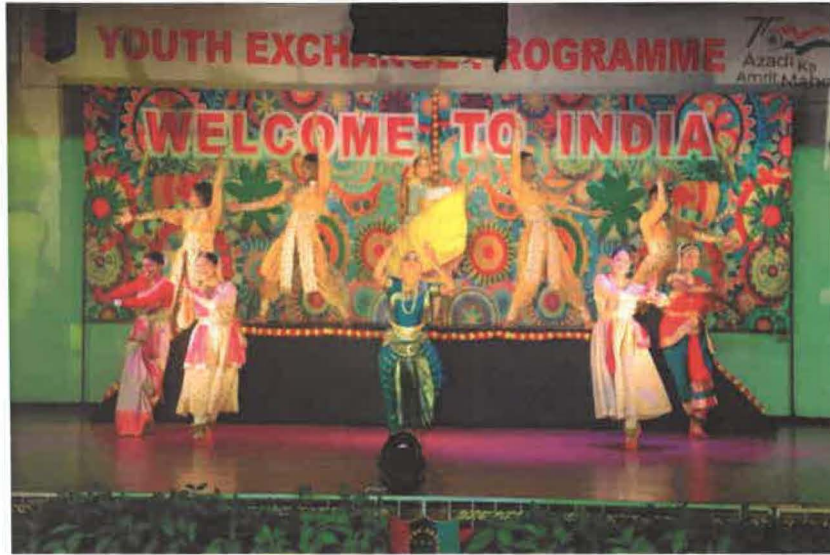
“Learning is a treasure that will follow its owner everywhere.”

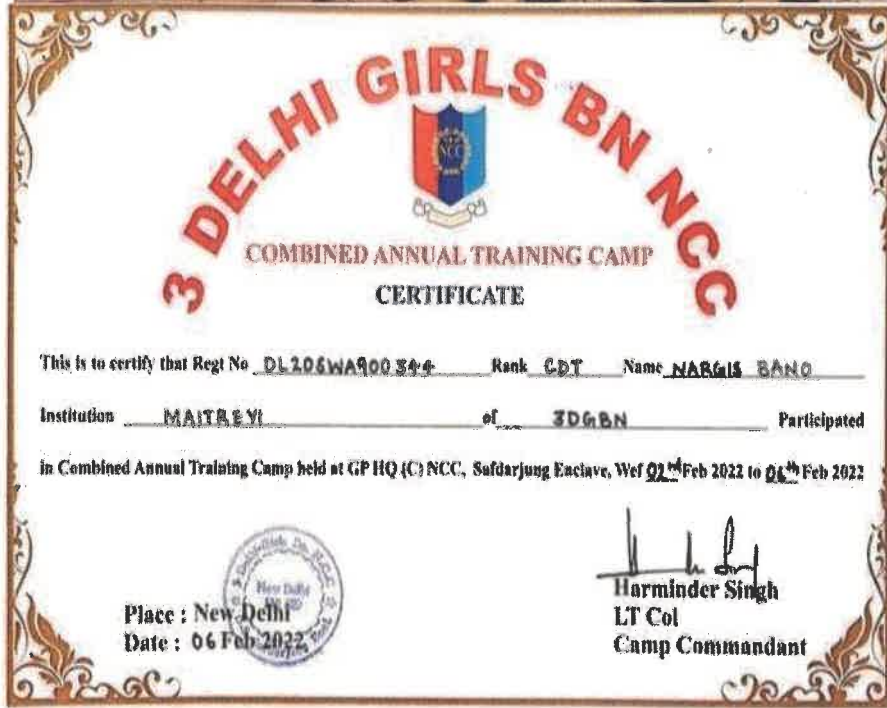
