


PRESIDENT'S MESSAGE


Gs score, Time and Revata education were also present and counseled students for further studies.





"A jack of all trades is a master of none!".


A prerequisite knowledge on what you're going to work upon before entering that line is a must. Let's first discuss why placements are better:

Why do students with higher education are preferred over students who go for campus placements:


- 1.Personal development: People with careers tend to lead more structured lives and have a stronger sense of responsibility, traits that serve as strength-builders in other areas of life.




IMPORTANCE OF PROFILE BUILDING IN PLACEMENT CELL




MAIN FOCUS OF PLACEMENT CELL
