The morning session started with a warm-up followed by running and ball-passing and many more activities that hone the individual skills of the athletes while match sessions between Special Olympics athletes and LGBTQ+ community during the evening hours. Presented by Toyata and modelled after the FIFA World CupTM, starting from July, The Special Olympics Unified Cup Detroit 2022 welcomed over 300 footballers with and without intellectual disabilities from over 20 nations to compete in football (soccer). ORGANISED BY: Maitreyi College (Physical Education Department)


NUMBER OF PARTICIPANTS: 160 students
